

Y-DNA Testing Status

For the unbroken lines: what the project needs most is at least one more Y-DNA test for a descendant of Richard (.113), born 1709 in Anne Arundel County, MD; died 1781; wife Keturah BARNES.

More participants from the line of Uriah SHIPLEY (.142), especially those not in the line of Grove SHIPLEY (.1421). Other descendants of Uriah SHIPLEY (.142) might be related.

For the broken lines:

DNA results give probabilities, therefore, “possibly related” means the Y-DNA shows that the participant may be a descendant of Adam Shipley (.1), but to be certain the participant is a descendant of that Adam he would need to upgrade to the Y-700.

“High probability” means the Y-DNA shows that the participant is a descendant of Adam Shipley (.1), but in order to determine which son and grandson of Adam the participant is descended, the participant would need to upgrade to the Y-700.

“Definitely related” means the Y-700 test has proven with 100% probability that the participant is a descendant of Adam (.1) “Not related” means that the Y-DNA test proves that they are not a descendant of Adam (.1). For those “possibly,” or “high probability” we highly encourage you to upgrade to a Y-700 test.

Only two broken lines have two participants, but the more test we have the better we are able to confirm patterns in the data.

Benjamin SHIPLEY.XF, b. about 1729 in AA Co., MD, d. 1803 in Washington Co., TN; married (1) Catherine (Kitty) HAWK and (2) Elizabeth _____. *Two participants, with a high probability of being related.*

Eli SHIPLEY .XK, b. 1748 in AA Co, MD, d. 1823 Sullivan Co., TN; married Elizabeth KINGSTON. *Two participants:one definitelyrelated; the other with a high probability of being related.*

Based on the information available in *The Shipleys of Maryland* 2002 edition, some broken lines appear not to have any living male Shipley descendants. Some broken lines have only one participant, so we need at least one more. Unless otherwise noted, there are no participants for the lines below. We would like to get at least two for each broken line.

The below information is a guide to which lines are needed for those who do not know the Henry numbers used in *The Shipley of Maryland* books.

Some of these broken lines may be related.

The .XX and .ZF lines may both be descendants of Robert Shipley .132 (b. 1713, married Sarah Dorsey, moved to NC in 1771.)

These lines may all be related: .XA, .XD, .XE, .XF, .XK, .XT, .XV, .XW, .XZ, .YA., .YB. They may be descendants of Richard Shipley (.113) 1709-1781, married Keturah Barnes. For more on this theory, see the document called "Shipley Broken lines theories" at cpuworks.com/ancestry/

Broken lines that need more participants:

.XA unknown SHIPLEY, children Benjamin, Adam, Henry, and Mary Ann are also listed as the children of Richard Shipley (.113). No male Shipley descendants found.

.XB Amon SHIPLEY, born 1804 in CR Co, MD; died there in 1885. Married (1) Aseneth POOL and (2) Mary Ann WILLIS.

.XC Andrew SHIPLEY, born near Baltimore in MD; married Jane BEAN. Lived in Washington Co., TN. No living Shipley male descendants found.

.XD Asa SHIPLEY, born in Knox Co., TN, d. about 1860; married Roseannah BEAN. No living male descendants found. Possibly related to Benjamin SHIPLEY (.XF).

.XE Benjamin SHIPLEY Sr., about 1710 (?), in England (?). Son Benjamin SHIPLEY married Elizabeth _____, granddaughter Mary SHIPLEY married Thomas SUTTON. Family lived BA/HA Co, MD.

.XG Benjamin Owen SHIPLEY, b. about 1813 in BA Co., MD; d. 1867. Married Margaret WHITE, lived in AA Co., MD.

.XH Charles SHIPLEY Sr., b. before 1755 near Baltimore MD, d. after 1810, moved to Fairfield Church PA. Married Susanna _____. The project already has *one participant with a high probability of being related, but we need one more participant.*

.XI Daniel SHIPLEY, born about 1768 in MD, d. 1887 in Washington Co., NE. Moved to OH around 1820. By 1830 lived in Knox Co., TN; son William Alexander SHIPLEY married Elizabeth BEAR.

.XJ Edward SHIPLEY, b. about 1760, d. about 1829 in Warren Co., TN. Married Elizabeth _____. Children Talbert, Tidence, John, probably others.

.XL Frederick SHIPLEY, b. 1782, d. 1826. Lived in FR Co., MD. Married Margaret CAIN. The project already has *one participant that is definitely related, but we need one more participant.*

.XM George W. SHIPLEY, b. about 1802 in MD; married Elizabeth Ann SHIPLEY in 1825 in BA Co., MD. Moved to Pipe Creek Township IN before 1842; lived in Madison Co., IN, in 1875.

.XN Isaac SHIPLEY, married Elizabeth ____; moved to IN about 1825. *The project has one participant who is possibly related.*

.XO John SHIPLEY, b. in PA; d. in 1827; married Elizabeth DALLAS. Lived in IN, moved to MO.

.XP John SHIPLEY. b. in 1789; d. 1859 in Putnam Co., MO. Married 3 times. Second wife Susan DAY. May be the son of Benjamin SHIPLEY (.XF) or of Richard SHIPLEY (.XV). First wife may be Mary "Nancy" Wright; third wife may be Letitia Nancy Green. *The project has one participant who is possibly related, but we need one more participant.*

.XQ John R. SHIPLEY, b. 1821; d. 1887 in CR Co., MD. Married Eliza Ann BARBER. *The project has one participant who is not related, so we need more participants.*

.XR John Thomas SHIPLEY, born 1833 in Baltimore MD; d. 1904. Married Virginia E. WATERS. Lived in Avalon and Elkridge MD. *Participant related to descendants of Grove Shipley (.1421). The project does not need anymore participants.*

.XS Thomas SHIPLEY, b. 1660; d. 1719 in Loxley England; married Dorothy _____. Grandson William Shipley (.XS2), a Quaker, arrived in Philadelphia in 1725; married (1) Mary TATNALL; (2) Elizabeth LEVIS.

.XT Nathaniel SHIPLEY, born 1765 in MD. Married Mary _____. May be from same family as .XA line. Moved to TN after 1794. *The project has one participant who is possibly related, but we need one more participant.*

.XU Peregrine SHIPLEY, b. in BA Co., MD. Married Orpha MORGAN, b. 1798 in Pikesville, BA Co., MD, and d. there 1885.

.XV Richard SHIPLEY, Sr, b. about 1775 in TN, d. about 1820 in Rhea Co., TN; married Hanna Retta HUGHES. Some think he is the father of John SHIPLEY (.XP) and the son of Benjamin SHIPLEY (.XF). *The project has one participant who has a high probability of being related, but we need one more participant.*

.XW Richard SHIPLEY, born about 1755; d. before 1804 in Sullivan Co., TN. Married Elizabeth ROLLER. May be the son of Benjamin SHIPLEY (.XF). *The project has one participant who is possibly related.*

.XX Richard Edward SHIPLEY, Sr. born 1797 in MD, died 1865. Married Elizabeth BENTON. Moved to WV. May be from line of Jesse SHIPLEY (.1399), who married Jane LUCAS. *The project has one participant who is definitely related. We need one more participant. We have additional evidence connecting this line to the unbroken line of Edward Shipley (.1329).*

.XZ Samuel SHIPLEY, born about 1751; d. 1839 in Monroe Co., KY. Revolutionary War veteran. Married Keturah SUTTON. May be the son of Benjamin SHIPLEY(.XF). *The project has two participants who are not related. Both participants are from the line of Uriah Hart SHIPLEY (.XZ11). More participants needed.*

.YA Samuel SHIPLEY, b. 1789 in MD; d. 1865 in IN. Married Frances CONDON. Son Samuel SHIPLEY .YA1 married Leah SHIPLEY .14116 in CA Co., MD in 1838. *The project has one participant with results pending. Need one more participant.*

.YB Samuel SHIPLEY, b. about 1824 in TN; d. 1894 in Bristol, Sullivan Co., TN. Married Lucinda JACKSON. Possibly the grandson of Eli SHIPLEY (.XK).

.YC Samuel J. SHIPLEY, b. 1829; d. 1888 in Jersey City, NJ. Married Elizabeth _____. *The project has one participant who is not related. More participants needed.*

.YD William SHIPLEY, b. about 1751 in MD; d. 1823 in OH. Believed to be a child of Samuel SHIPLEY (.XZ). (NOTE: Samuel Leatherwood SHIPLEY (.YD64) may be the line of Samuel (.114?). Name of first wife unknown; married (2) Rachel ARNOLD. *The project has one participant who may be related. Need one more participant.*

.YE William SHIPLEY, Sr., b. about 1795 in FR Co., MD, d. in Belmont Co., OH. Married Mary FLOYD. May be a child of William SHIPLEY (.YD).

.YF William P. SHIPLEY, b. 1817 in TN, d. 1881 in Clarke Co., IA. *The project has one participant who is possibly related. Need one more participant.*

.YG Adam SHIPLEY, married Catherine Hamilton, b. 1718 in Baltimore Co., MD. Their daughter Susannah SHIPLEY married Abel BROWN; and their grandson, Elias BROWN., Jr. was the first Carroll Countian elected to the U.S. Congress.

.YH Adam Shipley, married Rachel WHIPS. This Adam has been determined to be the son of Peter SHIPLEY (.14) (p. 19 of *The Shipleys of Maryland 2002 Edition*).

.YK Artemus SHIPLEY, b. 1816; married Arah MARR about 1839 in MD.

.YL Benjamin SHIPLEY, b. 1827 in Mt. Airy, MD; married Mary _____. His son was Charles Edward Shipley, who married Ellen Moore CRAMBLITT.

.YO Frederick SHIPLEY, married Dorothy Loretta MORRIS. Son Frederick E. SHIPLEY was born in 1947 in Baltimore, MD; married Margaret Foxwell.

.YP George SHIPLEY, b. 1788 in MD, d. 1867 in Noble Co., OH. Married Sarah GATRIL.

.YV John Keller SHIPLEY, b. 1839 in MD; d. 1912; married Rachel Amelia Dixon in CR Co., MD. Parents may have been Amon SHIPLEY and Miranda KELLER.

.YY Kenneth G. SHIPLEY, married Blanche MORRISON. Son Bernard E. SHIPLEY was born 1930 in Washington, D.C.; married Marilyn E. Tobin.

.ZB Robert H. SHIPLEY, died 1896; buried in Greenmount Cemetary in Baltimore, MD. Married H. Louise _____, who died 1878. Their son Edward Gettier SHIPLEY was born in 1864, died 1901, married Ida Virginia MIDDLEKAUFF.

.ZF William SHIPLEY, son Robert SHIPLEY II d. 1823 in MO, drowned moving cattle across a river. Grandson Robert SHIPLEY III, b. 1814 in Barren Co., KY; d. 1883 near Monroe Co., OR., married Charlotte MULKEY. (NOTE: appears this may be the same person as William SHIPLEY (.132A3), son of George SHIPLEY and Elizabeth McCORD.)

.ZG William Clifton SHIPLEY, b. 1898 in Baltimore, MD, d. 1964. , married Ruth Penfold GOUGH in 1920.
